Trip Policies Cancellation Policy

Full refunds, minus a \$6.00 administrative fee will be granted prior to **January 9th, 2012 for Homewood**, and prior to **February 21st, 2012 for Sugar Bowl**. There will be no refunds or transfers granted after **January 9th, 2012 for Homewood** or **February 21st for Sugar Bowl**.

No refunds for no shows; bus departs at 4:30am SHARP!

No alcoholic beverages, tobacco, illegal possessions or unseemly behavior will be tolerated.

Damage to the bus or ski resort(s) will result in payment by the participants' parent or guardian.

City staff will check the first aid station regularly. In case of injury, all expenses incurred will be the responsibility of the participant and their family.

Participants are not allowed to ski/board on their own. If found alone, participants will be required to ski/board with a recreation staff member.

Participants are required to check-in at the designated area in the ski resort at the appropriate times. Check-in times will be determined by a recreation staff member.

Participants and parents must agree to support the policies of the City of San Bruno Recreation Division. If a participant violates the trip agreements, his/her parent will be immediately notified and required to pick-up the individual at the ski resort. If necessary, the incident may be reported to the proper legal authority. In addition, the participant will not be eligible to participate in future City of San Bruno sponsored activities.
