“Hi Marty, I can’t attend the meeting tonight but I’d like to have you bring a few things up about the houses going in on Glenview.

Construction workers and trucks driving through the neighborhood, can we limit them access to entering and exiting through San Bruno Ave and Skyline, especially the big trucks ? It really puts a burden on an already overused street like Glenview, it’s become a shortcut again but so much busier now.

Also, Coyotes and other animals use part of that property for access to and from the canyon, I see coyotes going through there all the time. They walk through the driveway that leads to the house in the back and if it’s closed off I fear it may drive them farther into our neighborhood looking for another path to the canyon, like our backyards. It’s bad enough with them and mountain lions roaming around day and night the way it is. I wonder if any thought was given to this ?

One more thing. The through traffic here on Glenview has got ridiculously dangerous, so many speeders up and down and quite a few just blow the stop sign at Claremont and Glenview. I never see any traffic enforcement at all, be nice to see an officer sit and tag a few making California stops sometime, even once in awhile.
