Regarding item 7.a.:

Exhibit A of the proposed amendment (packet pages 118-128 and 139-149) describes the project area in highly technical terms which require specialized training to understand. Most members of the public do not have such expertise. Please confirm that the northern section of White Way between Kains Ave and San Bruno Ave will remain a city street (or alley) which will be accessible to the public by vehicle for its entire length. Please include that information in the agreement in plain English. New state laws such as SB9 affect property which is zoned for single family housing. Removing existing access to portions of those properties could negatively impact property owners' ability to exercise their rights under these laws.

ou were unable to connect me for public comment. I would like to address the Recology contract that s up for renewal. I have been working on school initiatives and finding sources of support and funding to help our public schools develop and grow to their potential. Within the Recology contract there is a section of fundraising and support. The existing 24yr contract states the following:

Section 5.9.3.2 Youth Contractor shall make its staff available to tour schools and provide classroom educational programs regarding recycling. The contractor shall also sponsor an annual "Cash for Class" fundraiser

Section 5.9.3.3. The contractor shall also participate in community sponsorships and participation in local events ....

Contractor shall also direct educational materials regarding initiation of materials etc... Please see this section of contract as well.

I know Recology sponsors large events for St Roberts private schools, we could use the same support in our public schools.

This is just part of the contract that promises to fundraise and support our schools. In 24yrs this has not happened. I'm asking on behalf of the children and our teachers and staff that you ask Recology to fulfill their promise with a one time donation of 24k or more for each year that their promise was unfulfilled or to ask a make good before you renew this contract.

The parents , teachers and children could use your leadership to see this through as promised in the contract. We could use the funding to improve our schools and programs.
