**Police** – Violence is increasing in the City, especially domestic violence. Scams are also on the rise. Many robberies happening. A woman followed from the bank was robbed. Her car doors were unlocked. A 7-11 was robbed and also a bank was robbed. The PD will have two new messages per month on different topics. A program from California may fund more officers.
