

## San Bruno Employee Identification Card

Every city employee will receive a City of San Bruno identification card. Please complete the *San Bruno ID Card Information form*. Once completed, return the form to your supervisor. Your supervisor will schedule you to go to the San Bruno Police Department to take your picture, take your fingerprint, and obtain your signature for a City of San Bruno identification card.

The back of the ID card states that you are “An Authorized Emergency Worker”. Under the California Government Code, Section 3100-3109, all persons employed by the county, city, state agency or public district in the State of California are obligated to serve as Disaster Service Workers. In the event of a declaration of emergency, any employee of the City of San Bruno may be assigned to perform activities which promote the protection of public health and safety or the preservation of lives and property. Such assignments may require service at locations, times, and under conditions that are significantly different than the normal work assignment and may continue into the recovery phase of the emergency.
