



San Bruno Public Library - 3D Printer Policy

Purpose

The San Bruno Public Library ("Library") offers community access to established, new, and emerging technologies to inspire creativity and independent learning among our patrons. This policy establishes guidelines for the public use of 3D printers, which create three-dimensional objects using a design uploaded from a digital computer file.

Guidelines

The 3D printer may only be used for lawful purposes. Library users may not create material that is:

- Prohibited by local, state or federal law.
- Unsafe, harmful, dangerous or poses an immediate threat to the well-being of others.
- Obscene or otherwise inappropriate for the library environment.
- In violation of another party's intellectual property rights.
- Regulated or requires a license to use or carry.

Users are limited to one print job per week. Appointments must be made 72 hours in advance.

Release of Liability

Patrons are responsible for their own safety regarding 3D printed items. The Library makes no warranties regarding the overall condition, fitness for use, or merchantability of the final printed item. By submitting content, patrons agree to assume all responsibility for, and shall hold the City of San Bruno and the Library harmless in, all matters related to patented, trademarked or copyrighted materials. If any of these policies are broken, either intentionally or unintentionally, the library reserves the right to deny access to future 3D printing for any period of time. Any patron whose actions result in damage to any equipment is liable for the cost of repairs/replacements.

Patrons agree to release and hold harmless the Library and City of San Bruno, its officers, employees, volunteers, committees and boards, from and against any and all liability, loss, damages, claims, or actions (including costs and attorney fees) for bodily injury and/or property damage, to the extent permissible by law. This indemnification and hold harmless agreement shall include indemnity against all costs (including without limitation, reasonable attorney's fees and court costs), expenses and liabilities incurred in or in connection with any such claim or proceeding brought thereon and in defense thereof. Submission of a digital computer file for 3D printing indicates that patrons have read and understand this liability waiver, indemnification, and hold harmless form, and that patrons voluntarily agree to its terms.
