



# **NOTICE OF STREET WORK**

CITY OF SAN BRUNO

PUBLIC WORKS – ADMINISTRATION AND ENGINEERING

**2023-24 and 2024-25 Street Rehabilitation Project**  
**Project No. 60039 & 60048**  
**Funded by Measure G, Measure A and Measure W**

This notice is to inform you that the City of San Bruno, Department of Public Works, will begin the 2023-24 and 2024-25 Street Rehabilitation Project (Project No. 60039 & 60048) in late Fall 2024. The roadways scheduled for pavement treatment were prioritized based on the City's Pavement Management Program, considering roadway classification and available funds. This project will repair portions of existing pavement and prevent rapid deterioration to maximize pavement longevity at various locations and install accessible curb ramps within project limits.

The City suggests that property owners inspect their sewer lateral and make any necessary repairs prior to the application of the pavement treatment. Sewer lateral repairs may require cutting into the roadway pavement which diminishes the value of the surface treatment and tax dollar investment. If done later, a paid encroachment permit will be required, and penalties will potentially be assessed related to opening a recently paved street surface.

### **Project Details:**

- **Construction Period:** Fall 2024 to Summer 2025
- **Work Hours:** Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM (excluding holidays)
- **Locations:** A list of the affected streets is provided below and shown on the attached map.

### **Construction Activities:**

1. **Accessible Curb Ramps:** Installation of new accessible curb ramps.
2. **Pavement Grinding and Base Repairs:** Removal of the existing pavement surface and underlying material, with repairs made to damaged areas if necessary.
3. **Asphalt Repaving:** Repaving the roadway with new asphalt; or
4. **Slurry Seal:** Treatment that spreads an asphalt emulsion and aggregate mixture on the street surface to provide a protective coating that protects the underlying pavement structure.
5. **Striping:** Restriping the road after roadway is repaved.

### **Street Closures and Parking Restrictions:**

During construction, temporary road closures will be necessary, and "No Parking" signs will be posted 72 hours in advance. Please note the posted times, dates, and locations, and park your vehicle outside the work area before 8:00 AM on the day of closure. **Vehicles left on the street will be towed at the owner's expense, and access to driveways within the project limits will be restricted until the work is complete.**

**Important Safety Information:**

It is crucial that the street is not used until it has properly cured. To prevent injury or damage, please **DO NOT DRIVE OR WALK ON THE STREET UNTIL ALL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES HAVE BEEN REMOVED AND THE STREET IS OPEN FOR USE.** Do not move any barricades, cones, or delineators. If you are unsure whether a street is open or need assistance with detours, please contact the City for guidance.

**Contractor Notifications:**

The Contractor, McKim Corporation, will provide construction information, including specific dates and times prior to construction. Notifications will be delivered to all properties along the affected streets at least 48 hours before any street closures for pavement grinding and repaving.

We understand that this project may cause some inconvenience, and we appreciate your patience and cooperation. The City is committed to completing the work efficiently with minimal disruption. If you have any questions, please contact:
