As part of the Shelter Creek Sewer Main Replacement and Portola Watershed Storm Drain Trunk Line Repair Project, the City of San Bruno's (City) contractor, K.J. Woods Construction, Inc., will begin construction to rehabilitate and replace deteriorated aging sewer main on Shelter Creek Lane to San Bruno Ave and San Bruno between Cherry Avenue and Traeger Avenue, and rehabilitate Portola watershed storm drain trunk line at Caltrans right-of-way near Sneath Lane.

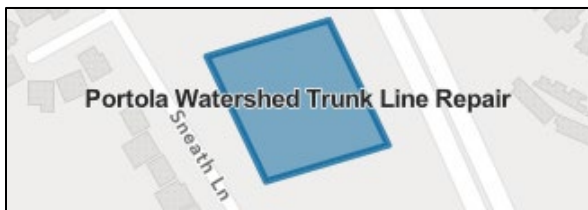
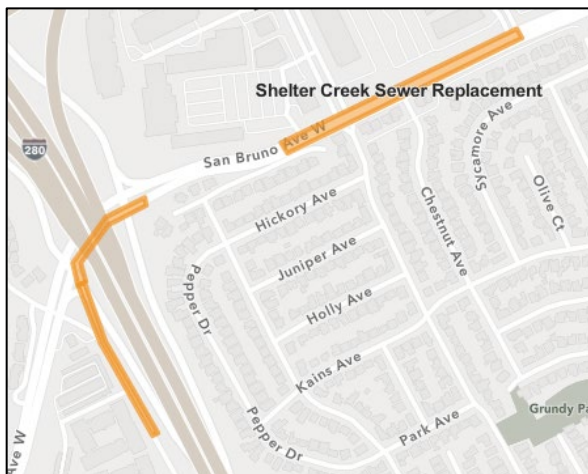
End Date: Fall 2026*

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- **PARKING:** Street parking will be impacted near construction zones. "No-parking" signs will be posted 72 hours in advance. Please note the time, date, and location of the posted temporary "no street parking" signs and plan to park accordingly.
- **TRAFFIC:** Temporary lane closures may occur near construction zones. Follow all traffic control signs and **DO NOT** move any barricades, cones, or delineators. Advance notice and detour signage will be provided, as needed.
- **ACCESS:** Businesses and residents in the work zone will have access to their driveways and entrances during construction.
- **NOISE:** Businesses and residents in the work zone will hear construction noise periodically during work hours, excluding weekends and holidays.
- **NOTICE:** Expect to receive additional notices from the City's Contractor.
