

POOL RULES

Thank you for choosing the San Bruno Park Pool. Please be aware of the following rules. The lifeguard has the right to discipline any person not following the rules.

1. Diving is only permitted on the south side of the 10-foot area.
2. NO RUNNING.
3. ONLY coastguard approved certified jackets are allowed. No swimsuits with built-in floatation devices, water wings, balls, are allowed.
4. If a child is wearing a coastguard-approved lifejacket, a parent must be in the water with the child.
5. No cutoffs, swimsuits only. Toddlers must wear swim diapers.
6. No children under the age of 10 allowed in the facility without a parent or guardian over the age of 18.
7. Children over the age of 5 may not enter the locker room of the opposite sex.
8. No fins or snorkel masks allowed.
9. No eating, drinking alcoholic beverages, or smoking in the facility.
10. Glass containers not allowed in the facility.
11. No gum chewing.
12. No bandages of any sort in the pool.
13. All patrons must shower before entering the pool.
14. No back dives, flips, or spins into the pool.
15. No rough or careless play.
16. No foul or offensive language.
17. No shoulder or back rides.
18. No hanging on the safety lines.

These rules are subject to change
