- b) **Update on Centennial Mosaic Mural Project:** Staff shared with the Commission that the artist has finished the life-size drawings and is currently working on the first two panels of tile work. Staff will contact the sub-committee (Livengood, Parker, Tobin) when the two panels are ready to be viewed and approved.
- c) **Report on Second Meeting with Skyline College Regarding Options for Public Art on Sneath Lane:** The sub-committee shared some information about the lengthy and involved process it is for a new class to be added to the college schedule. The Commission discussed other possibilities for the Sneath Lane Walls. Commissioner Gamble motioned to have the Commission continue to pursue a relationship with Skyline College in a collaborative effort to help students learn how to go through the public bidding process with possible funding toward Art. In conjunction, the Commission would like direct Staff to return to the November meeting with detailed information on options for the Sneath Lane walls, including "stretch" art and paint, seconded by Madden and approved unanimously.
- d) **Draft Schedule of Commission Goals for 2014-2015:** Commissioners were given a copy of the 2014-15 CAC Annual Calendar. After careful review by Commissioners, the calendar will be discussed at the next meeting.
- e) **Oral Report on Art Fund Balance:** Staff will update the Commission on the Art Fund Balance on a quarterly basis starting January, 2015.
