Position Title: Kitchen Assistant

How you can contribute: Aid in preparation of and serving of daily lunches, participate in pastry and donation sales to help subsidize daily lunch program.

Volunteer Tasks: Pick up donations from various local merchants including Lunardi's, Costco, Safeway and Lucky markets, sort and mark incoming donations, sell donations to public. Food preparation includes chopping, boiling, heating, shredding, and other basic kitchen skills. During lunchtime, volunteers serve portions onto trays and deliver them to patrons.

Helpful prior experience: Previous experience not required, though some cooking or restaurant experience is helpful.

Training: Volunteers may receive Serve Safe food service training from San Mateo County. Volunteers will also be trained in safe kitchen procedures as well as cleanliness standards.

Benefits for San Bruno Senior Center: Liaison with local merchants to continue the partnership that helps fund the lunch program, aid in service delivery of daily congregate meals, provide local seniors with healthy, affordable lunch options.
