



**CRESTMoor NEIGHBORHOOD STREETLIGHT OUTAGE
UNDERGROUND WIRE REPLACEMENT PROJECT**

February 16, 2016

Dear Resident,

The City is prepared to begin replacement of the underground wiring for the streetlight system in your neighborhood. At the January 12, 2016 meeting, the San Bruno City Council awarded a contract for this work to a local Bay Area contractor, St. Francis Electric, Inc. to perform the wire replacement in your neighborhood. This work is necessary to provide a permanent repair to the streetlight outage that has affected your neighborhood for the last several months. The work will consist of removing sections of the sidewalk at certain locations to install utility boxes, removing and installing new electrical wiring throughout the neighborhood, and performing operational testing of the electrical circuit. The replacement project is expected to begin on February 29, 2016 and be completed by May 2016.

During construction, there may be some equipment noise when sidewalk work is being done, dust, reduced street parking and sidewalk access. Weekday construction hours will be from 8:00am to 5:00pm. Work on Saturdays and Sundays is not anticipated. Temporary no-parking restrictions, if needed, will be posted between the hours of 7:30am and 5:30pm, three days prior to commencement of any construction activities. Pedestrian access along sidewalks will be diverted with signage when the construction requires removal of sidewalks in certain areas. Please park your vehicles on adjacent streets during construction hours and use the suggested detours when sidewalk work is being performed.

Once this work is completed, the temporary electrical connections to adjacent property owners' homes will be eliminated along with other temporary streetlighting measures currently in place. Thank you to each of the twenty-six (26) Crestmoor neighborhood residents who are participating in the temporary electrical connection program for your support and your assistance to keep the lights on until permanent repairs are completed.

The City would like to thank everyone in the neighborhood for your cooperation, understanding, and patience throughout the construction phase while the City works toward a long-term solution to the Crestmoor Neighborhood streetlight system outage.
