Flowering Plum					
25' Height	25' Spread	Medium Growth	OK in Full Sun	Various Soils	Rounded Shape



Crepe Myrtle					
15-25' Height	6-15' Spread	Fast Growth	OK in Full Sun	Various Soils	Vase Shape



Washington Hawthorn					
25-30' Height	25' Spread	Medium Growth	OK in Full Sun	Various Soils	Pyramidal Shape



Crab Apple					
15-20' Height	15-20' Spread	Medium Growth	OK in Full Sun	Various Soils	Rounded Shape



Bradford Pear					
12-20' Height	12-20' Spread	Fast Growth	OK in Full Sun	Various Soils	Oval Shape
