1) Personnel Changes

New Fire Agency Representative to our Division, Battalion Chief Brad Hartzell, from North County Fire Authority in Daly City. BC Hartzell replaces BC Dave Puccu from Redwood City Fire Department.

2) EOC/Plans Updates

Updates of the following documents to our EOP, as of January 2016

- Annexes for Landslide, Fuel Emergency are being reviewed by the County's Emergency Management Association. A Transportation Accidents Annex is being reviewed by OES staff - March 2016.

3) EOC Activations

- Pacifica to support their local state of emergency for coastal bluff loss from sea and rainfall runoff / erosion events December 2015-January 2016. County partnered in Initial Damage Assessment and Tour of Damages with CalOES Recovery Branch personnel.
- Super Bowl 50

4) Training

- Ongoing – Floor Warden Training – CERT classes for 100 county staff, designated as Flood Wardens in buildings around the County Center campus, Redwood City.

5) Exercise/Drills

Routine - monthly outdoor sirens testing.

6) Other

• County Extreme Weather Task Force Updates

- Jan 2016, Drought TF renamed to Extreme Weather TF.
- 12/1/2015 Skylonda Mutual Water Company was authorized to make an emergency connection to California Water Service Company granted by SFPUC in December; and has since disconnected as of 2/27/16 to their primary water source.
- 2/1/2016 County Public Works is researching an additional 12 rain gages countywide to bolster six Sheriff's OES owned gages.
- 2/29/2016 Redwood Glen Christian Camp, Loma Mar, CA closed their business due to a water supply/community water system. 23 staff residents may remain on the property until alternate employment and housing sought.
