On Thursday, October 13, 2016, at approximately 3:31 p.m., San Bruno Police Officers responded to a hotel located on the 1000 block of Bayhill Drive in San Bruno regarding a large number of credit, gift, and cash cards located inside of a room. A further examination revealed that the names and numbers had been removed from the cards. Removing this information is a common practice for those wishing to add different names and numbers on the cards for the purpose of committing fraud and theft.

A subsequent investigation led officers to twenty-eight year old Pacifica resident Erica Cloud. Upon making contact with Cloud, officers learned that she was using the fraudulent cards to commit identify theft. Cloud was arrested and booked into the San Mateo County Jail for charges related to identity theft, the unlawful possession of access card information, and the possession of drug paraphernalia.
