On Sunday, November 6, 2016, at approximately 7:06 p.m., a San Bruno Police Officer noticed a vehicle traveling on San Bruno Avenue near Crestmoor Drive. A subsequent investigation revealed that the vehicle had been reported stolen to the South San Francisco Police Department. San Bruno Police Officers contacted the driver of the vehicle, identified as twenty-two year old San Bruno resident Blake Fabris. Fabris refused to comply with the Officers' commands and threatened to kill a police canine. He was subsequently arrested and booked into the San Mateo County Jail for charges related to the possession of a stolen vehicle, threatening an officer, resisting/delaying a peace officer, and the possession of paraphernalia used to ingest controlled substances.
