On Wednesday, November 16, 2016, at approximately 11:04 a.m., Bruno Police Officers responded to the Tanforan Mall regarding the report of a subject armed with some type of bat that had stolen items from a store at that location. Responding officers located and detained a subject matching the description provided at the scene.

A subsequent investigation revealed the subject, identified as forty-nine year old Pittsburg, California resident Marcel Criner, had taken items from a store within the mall and threatened employees with a table leg as he fled. Criner was arrested and booked into the San Mateo County Jail for charges related to robbery and the possession of narcotics, as well as pursuant to outstanding warrants that had been issued for his arrest.
