**SUBJECT:** **Suspect Arrested for Vehicle Theft and Possession of Stolen Property**

On Tuesday, December 13, 2016, at approximately 11:15 a.m., San Bruno Police Officers discovered a subject sleeping in a parked vehicle at Forest Lane and Masson Avenue. The vehicle had been reported stolen out of San Francisco in mid-November. The vehicle's occupant, thirty year old San Francisco resident Renato Novicio, was found to be in possession of burglary tools and stolen property.

A subsequent investigation connected much of the recovered property to vehicle burglaries in San Francisco, Mill Valley and San Bruno. Novicio was arrested and booked into the San Mateo County Main Jail for charges related to vehicle theft, the possession of stolen property, the possession of burglary tools, and identity theft.
