


Total Cases by Day





Cases by Age Group




Cases by Sex




Deaths by Sex




New Cases by Day

Deaths by Race/Ethnicity




Because of limited testing capacity, the number of cases detected through testing represents only a small portion of the total number of likely cases in the County. COVID-19 data are reported as timely, accurately, and completely as we have available. Data are updated as we receive information that is more complete and will change over time as we learn more. Cases are lab-confirmed COVID-19 cases reported to San Mateo County Public Health by providers, commercial laboratories, and academic laboratories, including reporting results through the California Reportable Disease Information Exchange. Cases are counted by date the lab result was reported.

Total Cases by Day



▲ Modified operations and restrictions remain in effect




- All Boards, Commissions, and Committees meetings remain cancelled

Shelter in Place Order

- ▲ The County announced on Monday, April 27, 2020 that the Public Health Office will issue revised Shelter in Place order later this week
 - “..largely keep the current restrictions in place and extend them through May. The new order will include limited easing of specific restrictions for a small number of lower-risk activities...”


