On Wednesday, September 28, 2016, at approximately 5:50 p.m. San Bruno Police Officers responded to a residence on the 1000 block of National Avenue in San Bruno regarding the report of a possible residential burglary. A subsequent investigation revealed that sometime between 2:30 p.m. and 5:00 p.m., the front door to the residence had been forced open. However, nothing was taken from inside the residence.
