Possession of Narcotics Paraphernalia

On Wednesday, September 28, 2016, at approximately 5:08 pm, San Bruno Police Officers responded to the 900 block of San Mateo Avenue in San Bruno regarding the report of a vehicle collision. A subsequent investigation revealed that one of the involved parties, twenty-seven year old South San Francisco resident Raheem Isaq, had been driving while under the influence at the time of the collision. Isaq was also found to be in possession of narcotic paraphernalia. Furthermore, Isaq's actions were found to be in violation of the terms of his parole.

Isaq was arrested and booked in the San Mateo County Jail for charges related to driving under the influence, possessing narcotics paraphernalia, and violating the terms of his parole.
