SUBJECT: Arrest – Manufacturing Fraudulent Transit Tickets and Possession of Stolen Property

On Saturday, October 8, 2016, at approximately 4:01 p.m., San Bruno Police Officers contacted an individual acting suspiciously on Cherry Avenue near Interstate 380 in San Bruno. An initial investigation revealed the subject, identified as thirty-nine year old San Francisco resident William Hutcheon, was in possession of burglary tools. A further inquiry revealed that Hutcheon was in possession of items taken in an auto burglary in the City of San Francisco the previous evening. Hutcheon was also found to have been altering public transit tickets for the purpose of creating fraudulent tickets.

Hutcheon was arrested and booked into the San Mateo County Main Jail for charges related to the manufacture of fraudulent public transit tickets, the possession of hundreds of expired public transit ticket for the purpose of creating fraudulent tickets, the possession of stolen property, and the possession of burglary tools.
