SUBJECT: Arrest – Assault with a Deadly Weapon on a Police Officer

On Wednesday, October 12, 2016, at approximately 8:27 p.m., San Bruno Police Officers responded to the 500 block of El Camino Real regarding the report of a car burglary in progress. Officers responded to the scene and initiated a traffic stop of the suspect vehicle. The driver failed to yield to officers and drove his vehicle at an officer who was on foot. The officer fired once at the vehicle and the vehicle drove away at a high rate of speed. Officers pursued the suspect vehicle and with the assistance of the California Highway Patrol and the San Francisco Police Department, the suspect, identified as twenty-five year old San Francisco resident Vernon Evans-Carmichael, was arrested in the City of San Francisco. No subjects were injured during this incident.

Evans-Carmichael was booked into the San Mateo County Jail for charges related to assault on a police officer with a deadly weapon, possession of stolen property, evading a police officer, and pursuant to outstanding warrants that had been issued for his arrest.
