SUBJECT: Reserve Police Officer Recruitment

The San Bruno Police Department is actively recruiting volunteers to serve our community as Reserve Police Officers. Reserve Police Officers are valued members of the San Bruno Police Department. Reserve Officers are unpaid volunteers who support and assist the Department in various ways.

For over thirty-five years Reserve Officers have ensured the protection of life and property, the preservation of public peace, and the enforcement of laws. Reserve Police Officers are expected to commit at least sixteen hours per month to the program. Applicants should possess the knowledge and ability to exercise sound judgment in evaluating situations and making decisions; perform work requiring good physical condition; good customer service; communicate clearly and concisely, both orally and in writing. Reserve Officers take direction from supervisors. They're dependable in meeting scheduled assignments, and perform duties as assigned. Reserve applicants must be twenty-one years of age at date of hire with no felony convictions or other disqualifying criminal history. Candidates must pass a background investigation; be a U.S. citizen or a permanent resident alien who is eligible, and applied for U.S. citizenship; possess a high school diploma or GED; and possess and maintain, a valid California Driver's License. Reserves must also possess one of the following:

- **Level 1 Reserve:** Completion of the POST Basic Course (333 hours)
- **Level 2 Reserve:** Completion of Reserve Officer Modules II and III (333 hours)
- Basic Training Academy Certificate dated within past thirty months from the date of hire, or
- Proof of current enrollment in a California POST Basic Training Police Academy and must successfully complete the academy prior to appointment.

1. Application (online at CalOpps.org)
2. Brief resume detailing qualifications for the position
3. Verification of POST Basic or Reserve Academy certification (Level 1 or 2)
